

REGISTRATION & DUES

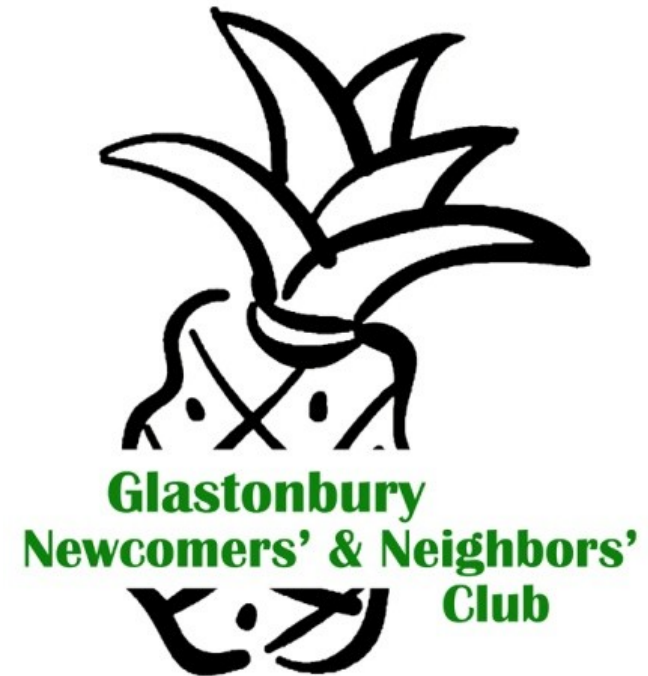

MISSION STATEMENT

The **Glastonbury Newcomers' and Neighbors' Club** is a non-profit social and civic organization whose purpose is to **welcome** new residents to Glastonbury, provide an environment where new and long-time residents can foster lasting friendships, provide programs and social activities of interest to members, and promote community involvement and philanthropy.

ACTIVITIES

Adult Socials: Three to four times a year the club offers adult social events. Past events include an Oktoberfest, Martini Night, Bunco, bowling, wine tasting, dinner out and others.

Book Groups: In the fall the club organizes new book groups and/or adds new members to existing book groups.

Community Enrichment: Several times a year the Club initiates and administers food, clothing and other drives to help members of our Glastonbury community. Annually donations are made to community organizations and neighbors in need.

Community Liaisons: The Club coordinates with the Town Center Initiative of Glastonbury to put on the Christmas Tree Lighting.

Facebook: Club members can interact with other members through Facebook – start a conversation, leave a message or ask a question. This is a valuable resource to just our Club

community which include long-time residents and newcomers of Glastonbury .

Family Socials: The club offers several family events each year. Past events include a Halloween bonfire, a holiday party, an ice skating/pizza party, an Easter egg hunt, outdoor movie, pool party and others.



Helping Hands: The club provides meals or flower arrangements are sent to member families who have a need including birth or adoption, illness or death in the family.

Ladies' Day Events: Each month the club plans an outing for ladies who have free time during the day. Past events include luncheons, spa outings, rose garden tour and others.

Ladies' Night Out: Monthly the club plans an outing for the ladies of the club. Past events include dinner out, yoga class, spa treatments, recipe swap, cooking class and more.

Men's Basketball: Pick-up games are held on Tuesday nights from 8:00 – 9:30 p.m.



Men's Golf: The club has a league that plays on Tuesdays, May – August.

Playgroups: In the fall the club coordinates playgroups for new members with children in the same age range.

Tot Tours: Each month we plan an outing for the children in the club. Past events include a visit to apple and pumpkin picking, hay rides, pizza making, cupcake decorating, park/gym dates, art class, fire station tours, karate class, library story hour and many others.
